

Elisabeth Pollio, Ph.D. is the Director of Mental Health Administration at the Child Abuse Research Education and Service (CARES) Institute and an Associate Professor at the Rowan University School of Osteopathic Medicine. Dr. Pollio oversees the administrative aspects of the Institute's mental health services, the Institute's foster care program, which provides mental health screenings and medical evaluations to children entering foster care, and the Institute's postdoctoral fellowship program, which provides specialized trauma training. She contributes to research at the Institute as well. Dr. Pollio also has provided and supervised Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT) and assists with the coordination and implementation of TF-CBT learning collaboratives, particularly through her work with agency leaders.
