#### Homelessness in Brantford - Brant

- ↑ rental costs
- ↑ complexity of mental health and addiction concerns
- ♠ barriers

#### 2024 PiT Count Findings:

- 43% were unsheltered in a public place
- 65% are aged 25-49 yo
- 64% identify as Indigenous













## Challenges

- Legal Decisions around Encampments
- Staffing Limitations
- Length of time between:
  - Encampment identification
  - Outreach
  - Bylaw attendance
  - Parks cleanup
- Communication
  - Between organizations and staff
  - To encampment residents













#### What We Did

- Dedicated Interdisciplinary Team to respond to encampments
- Reviewed encampment SOPs and review/update regularly based on legal decisions
- Engaged with Community Partners

- The January 2023 decision by the Superior Court of Justice in the case of <u>The Regional Municipality of Waterloo v.</u>
   Persons Unknown and to be Ascertained, 2023 ONSC 670 (CanLII); and
- The November 2023 decision by the Superior Court of Justice in the case of <u>The Corporation of the City of Kingston v.</u>
   <u>Doe, 2023</u> ONSC 6662 (CanLII).
- The December 2024 decision by the Superior Court of Justice in the case of <a href="Heegsma v. Hamilton (City">Heegsma v. Hamilton (City</a>) ONSC 7154

#### Community Paramedics – Outreach Program

- Collaborative effort between CP Team and other community organizations
- Goal is to meet people where they are at, provide supplies/supports to keep them safe and avoid hospitalizations
- 1,049 individual client contacts in 2024

#### 2024 Encampment Team Outcomes

- Since July 2023, we have attended **422** encampments
- In 2025 (Jan 1 to-date) there have been **129** complaints about encampments recorded only 35 have been true encampments
- 2024:
  - 246 total encampments
  - 154 unique individuals
  - 72 repeat encounters
  - 79 declined services


